## MEMBERS BROOMHEAD & SAUL SHORTLISTED FOR THE LAW SOCIETY'S 'EXCELLENCE IN TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION' AWARD.

From Dr Nicholas Bevan, partner at Taunton Chamber of Commerce member business Broomhead & Saul:

*"We are delighted to announce that we have been shortlisted for the Law Society's Excellence in Technology and Innovation Award. Our nomination featured our ground breaking and controversial legal research that debunked a widely held misconception in our profession that believed that because the formalities for executing a will are set out in section 9 of the Wills Act 1837, it would not be possible to use video conferencing technology to witness a self-isolating testator's signature during the lockdown. We exposed serious flaws in the Law Commission's Making a Will report and set a national precedent by administering the nation's first video will from our offices in 10 Hammet Street, Taunton on 1 May. We then embarked on a highly successful solo law reform campaign that led to the most significant change to the formalities for executing a Will since 1677"*

Initiative 1: The Law Society, various Chancery chambers and the August Authority of the Law Commission itself were all lined up against us in asserting that using video conferencing to witness a Will during the Covid 19 lockdown would create invalid wills because the Wills Act 1837 could never have envisioned this technology being used to manifest a testamentary witness' 'presence' to evidence the identity of the person / testator signing the Will. Our independent research demonstrated that not only was this modern technology consistent with the fraud prevention objective of the 1837 Act but, properly managed, it enhanced the fraud prevention measures.

We went ahead, to help various self-isolating clients) acting in defiance of the official guidance and then ran a solo campaign to persuade the government to issue official guidance (within a matter of weeks) followed up by emergency legislation that retrospectively clarified the law to sanction what we did (passed with astonishing speed within just over 3 months of our first

letter to the Secretary of State). As any lawyer can confirm – practically no non-Brexit related legislation was been considered at this time and the government rarely ever enacts legislation with retrospective effect. Our video Wills Service

Initiative 2: We were the only law firm to conceive of a Park Up Law Service, which we incepted in January this year and operated, with SCC permission, from the front of our offices during the lockdown. This addressed the problem faced by members of the public who need to make statutory declarations (to bury relatives or proceed with property transactions or a host of other scenarios) or to swear affidavits or have their ID certified and / or signatures witnessed. Vulnerable citizens from all across the county were able to drive up and receive these basic services from the safety of their parked up cars, with Dr Bevan delivering the legal services from the pavement.

Both initiatives, show that Taunton leads the filed in private client work nationally. Also, we have now opened a remote expat service to serve our clients in Europe and America.

Taunton Chamber Membership and Events Manager Bethan was delighted to be approached recently by a member business looking to make an anonymous donation to fellow member The Mango Tree Restaurant on Lower Middle Street, to enable them to fund the repair of their signage which had been vandalised for a second time.

At the time, owner Prem Anand had posted on The Mango Tree social media: *"A few months ago someone become fond of the tree icon from our signboard and we replaced after it disappeared. Last weekend the 'g' from our outside signboard also went missing. We wonder if any of the things that are deliberately nicked are of any use to the people who did it? It has been an extremely challenging time for the hospitality sector and we have to factor in the cost of new covid-safe procedures as well as staff shortages and some reluctance from customers to return. There have been a number of similar thefts of signage in the area, mostly targeting small independent businesses. Most of us are considerate and have*

*respect for others' property and hard work - it is disheartening that there are a few who don't care about how their actions affect others, especially in these challenging times"*

The anonymous donation, made through the Taunton Chamber came from a business that by their own admission, has thrived during the pandemic as a result of being in "the right industry at the right time" and which felt it was only right to make a donation to "pay it forward to a fellow member business who go out of their way to rise above the difficulties of the pandemic"

Prem was thrilled to receive such a heart-felt show of support from the local business community: *"We are most grateful towards the anonymous donor who funded for the replacement of the letter 'g' following our post about vandalism, through the Taunton Chamber of Commerce. Humility lives and we are all a part of this - this means so much to us. Donor you have made us feel good - we wish you joy and success."*

### UK BUSINESS CLIMATE HUB

In the first instance, we are calling on all members to sign up to the UK Business Climate Hub <https://smeclimatehub.org/uk/> a UN-backed commitment process, where firms and organisations of all sizes will be joining a community of thousands of like-minded businesses and will receive regular newsletters and information from UK government to support you through your eco-journey.

### ENHANCED CAPITAL ALLOWANCES FOR EFFICIENT TECHNOLOGIES

Speak to your accountant about the Enhanced Capital Allowance (ECA) scheme, which aims to encourage businesses to invest in efficient technologies. The scheme lets your business claim 100 per cent first-year allowances, ie tax relief, on

investments in certain technologies and products. This means you can write off, ie deduct, the whole cost, or up to the published claim value, of buying the energy-saving product against your taxable profits in the year of purchase - and using the equipment itself will help reduce the impact your business has on the environment.

### LOCAL ACTIVITY - SUPPORT FOR TAUNTON CHAMBER MEMBERS

## Apply for a Carbon Grant

# BUSINESSES IN SOMERSET CAN APPLY FOR A CARBON REDUCTION GRANT OF BETWEEN £500 AND £1,000 TO HELP IMPROVE THEIR CARBON FOOTPRINT.

The grant is being made available by the five councils in Somerset as part of the Climate Emergency Strategy

**FROM SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL:** Collectively, our businesses all contribute to Somerset's carbon emissions, so every business can play a part in helping reduce our overall use of energy, reducing carbon emissions and the carbon footprint of Somerset.

To help meet our goals, we are asking businesses across Somerset to consider how they can reduce their use of energy. Some actions can easily produce results -for example, replacing conventional lighting with low energy lighting, while others require planning – like introducing a workforce car-share initiative. Some businesses may wish to implement a programme of actions to help reduce their carbon emissions.

To enable businesses to explore all the possibilities, we have produced a Carbon Audit Toolkit for Businesses which details websites that offer help and advice from a variety of agencies and sources.

### **BENEFITS FOR YOUR BUSINESS**

Cutting carbon emissions offers benefits to our businesses as well as to the environment. These include:

- Reduced energy bills and exposure to future energy price rises
- Improved cash flow
- Increased profitability, productivity and competitiveness
- Improved green credentials, which helps to attract and retain the right quality of staff
- The ability to win new contracts, especially with the public sector
- A more comfortable working environment and improvements to air quality
- Contributing to a reduced carbon footprint for Somerset and wider benefits to society

Carbon Reduction for Business Grant Scheme Grants of between £500 and £1000 are available to any Somerset businesses wishing to introduce and implement carbon reduction measures to their business. The grant must be 'match funded' by the business applying for the grant on a 50:50 basis.

Applications will be accepted until 30 September 2021, but the number of grants available under this scheme is limited and the scheme will cease when that limit is reached.

### **WHO CAN APPLY**

Grant applications are permitted from;

- Small, medium and large business including unincorporated businesses – for example, partnerships, societies, clubs, sole traders
- Any business based within the administrative county of Somerset can apply

Guidelines have been produced about who can apply for a grant, what sort of projects might qualify and what assistance can be applied for.
